

The Society of Ohio Archivists is an active organization with a vibrant membership. The SOA serves to promote the collection, preservation, and availability of manuscript and archival resources in the state, and to promote cooperation with professionals in related fields.

In addition, the association brings to public attention the importance of archival resources to historians, students and genealogists. As an organization, we provide educational opportunities through our many workshops and the annual meeting and conference. We promote archival awareness through such activities as Archives Week and participation in History Day.

The Society of Ohio Archivists was the first formally organized state archival organization in the country.

Governance

SOA is governed by a constitution and bylaws. The leadership of SOA is vested in the Council, composed of the president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and four council members. Standing committees are appointed by the president and confirmed by the Council. Other committees are formed to deal with special areas of professional interest. These committees report to the Council.

Benefits and Levels of Membership

In addition to furthering archival interests within the state of Ohio, SOA members receive the following benefits:

Annual meetings. Each year, SOA holds a conference in different areas of the state. Topics addressed in the past include copyright, outreach, exhibits, education, digital preservation, and certification. SOA members receive discounted rates at conferences and workshops.

The Ohio Archivist. This online newsletter provides information about upcoming meetings, feature articles, technical news, as well as reports and minutes from the Council meetings. Members may request printed copies of this publication.

Individual membership. Members have voting rights at the annual business meeting.

Institutional memberships. Institutional members receive discounts for up to two employees to attend the annual meeting at a discounted rate.
