





Need for History Fund

2012-'13 (first year):

- 64 applications / \$891,000 in requests.
- \$108,000 granted to 10 organizations

2013-'14:

- 64 applications / \$788,000 in requests.
- \$110,000 granted to 10 organizations.



Need for History Fund

- More contributions to "tax check-off" = more \$\$\$ to grant to your organizations
- To date, tax check off = \$143,000. Must generate \$150,000 by December 31





- Project length: up to 1 year
- Match requirement: 80/20
- Funds distribution: 50% of the grant amount at the beginning of the project; 50% at end.



- Grant amounts: \$2,000 \$20,000
- Project length: up 2 years
- Match requirement: 60/40
- Funds distribution: 50% of the grant amount at the beginning of the project; 50% paid at end.



BRICKS & MORTAR


- Work on properties on National Register of Historic Places
- Work on a building used for the preservation of historical or archival collections regardless of the building's historic status.
- New construction dedicated to the preservation of historical or archival collections.

BRICKS & MORTAR

- Grant amounts: \$2,000 \$20,000
- Project length: up to 2 years
- Match requirement: 60/40
- Funds distribution: 20% of grant paid at the beginning of the project. Remainder paid over life the grant on a reimbursement basis.



BRICKS & MORTAR – continued

- Bricks and Mortar projects require a maintenance agreement
 - Property owner agrees to maintain the historic features of the property (for historic properties), or retain the building for its intended use (for non-historic) for 5 years.



Ineligible Projects – History Fund

- See History Fund Grants Guidelines handout for full list
- Purchase of collections.
- Buildings moving or reconstructing
- Buildings remodeling: projects to remodel or modernize building interiors unrelated to the guidelines above.
- Copyright: projects that would convert to a digital format materials that the applicant intuition does not hold the copyright to.
- Costs of operation, such as utilities, security system maintenance fees, grounds keeping, hosting services for website, digital image storage, etc.

OHIO HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Ineligible projects – History Fund

- Public works of art.
- Grants to erect or repair Ohio Historical Markers. For grants for markers, see www.remarkableohio.org
- Oral history that does not focus on a particular subject or theme.
- Contact the History Fund at Ohio Historical Society if you have a question about whether an activity is eligible for funding.

- Mid-June: Application available at www.ohiohistory.org/historyfund
- September 3, 2014: Applications due
- February 2015: Funding decisions announced
- May 2015: Project periods start (12 to 24 months)
