How does DPLA work?



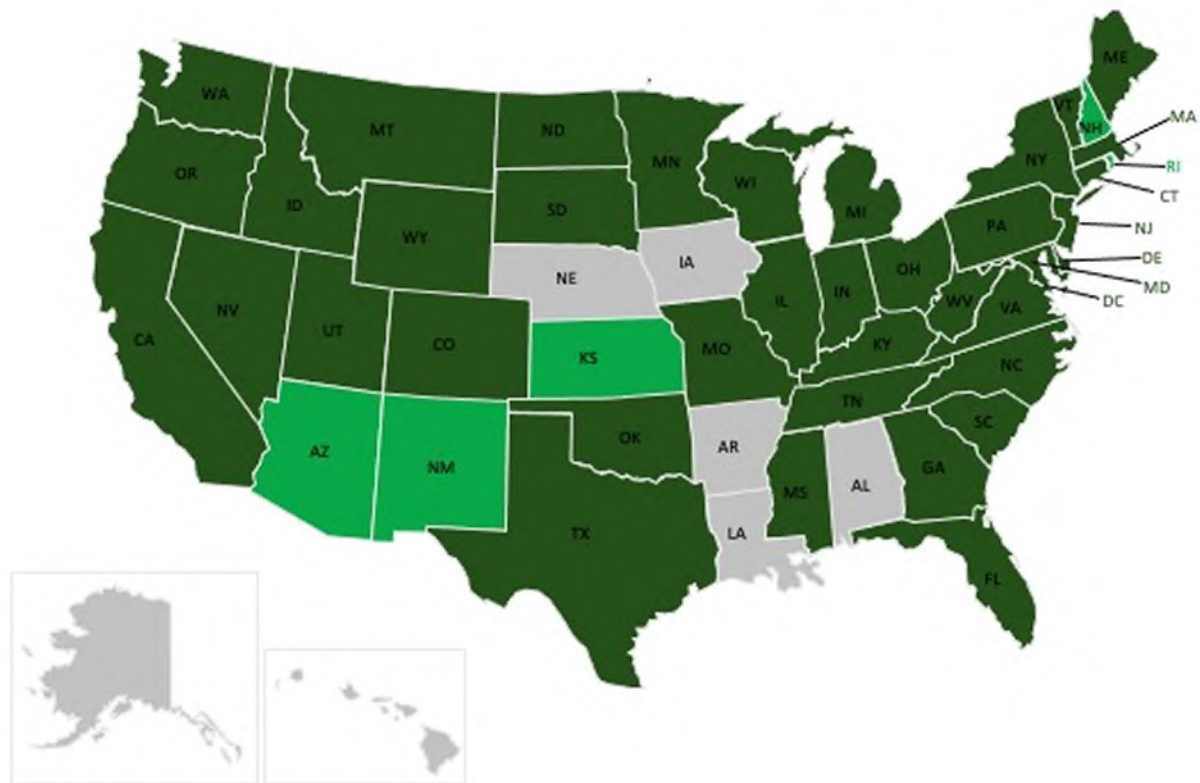

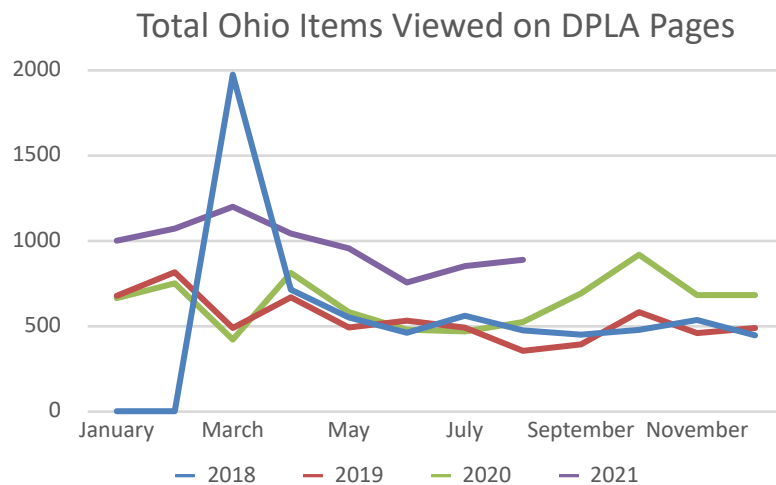

- The harvest process is handled by the State Library Staff. Your metadata just needs to meet specific requirements



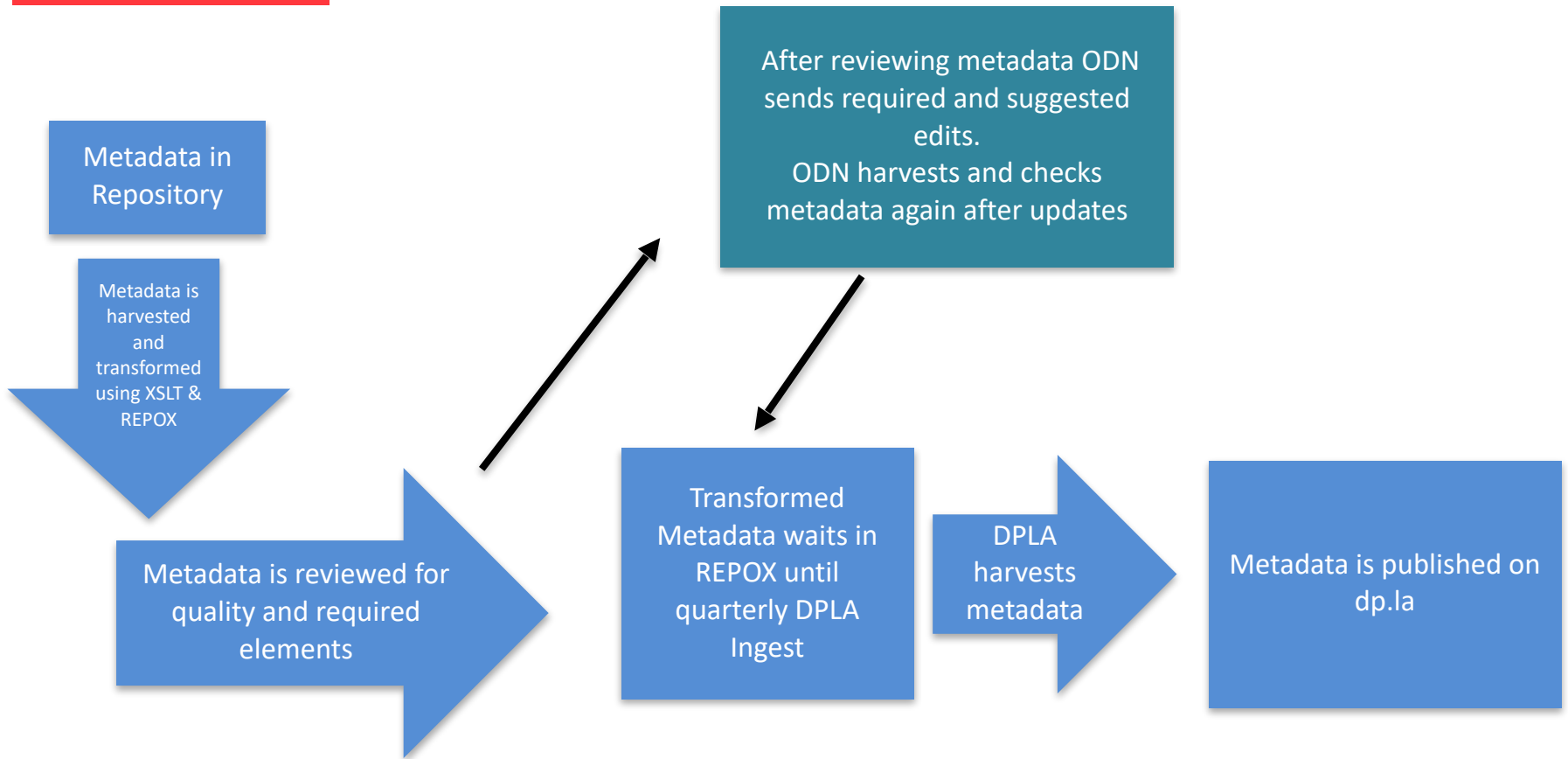

Standardized Rights Statement

Recommended and Optional Elements

Recommended Elements enhance user experience by providing more detail about the item. Some of the recommended elements are faceted.

Optional Elements are fields that the data provider to use fields specific to the metadata schema or add even more detail about the item.

IIF Manifest Harvesting

- Know your rights! All Wikimedia items need to be copyright free
- Let ODN know you would like to include manifests for a specific collection
- ODN Staff adds manifests
