- i. Long Morehart – New Spring newsletter is out.

d. Representatives

i. Ohio Historical Records Advisory Board (OHRAB)

1. McGuire – OHRAB met last Friday. Presentation with Kelly Matthews from OhioNET regarding OHRAB strategic planning process. Board approved \$2,000 from last year's budget to transfer to this year's budget for extra grant funds.

1. Long Morehart – Survey being distributed. Please share.

4. New Business

a. Approval/appointment of 2026-2027 Committee Chairs

- i. Long Morehart calls to approve Katie Gable as Marketing & Communications Co-Chair. Ganz motions, McGuire seconds, motion approved.

b. Approval/appointment of 2026-2027 Strategic Planning Committee members

- i. Vice President Kristen Newby – In March, we discussed that Strategic Plan costs with Ohio Humanities were more than expected. One question was could we make two installments (\$4,500 total)? Ohio Humanities prefers this. \$2,250 this budget cycle, \$2,250 next fiscal year. Package includes a member survey, three virtual focus groups, one 6-hour planning session with follow-up, action/communication plan, one-year support.

1. Newby calls to approve \$4,500 Ohio Humanities Strategic Plan costs split into two installments of \$2,250. McGuire motions, JEDAI Co-Chair Hannah Kemp-Severence seconds, motion carries.

- ii. Newby – Strategic Plan Committee time commitments include attendance at 6-hour planning meeting, follow up meeting, and review of plan. Members are also asked to attend one of the three virtual focus groups. Plan will start with the membership survey, then the focus groups, which will guide the Strategic Plan process. Committee should include the President, Vice President, Past President, one JEDAI Co-Chair, one At-Large Council Member, and someone not on council.

1. Ganz – We should include one early career/student to take their perspectives into account.

- a. Newby – Agreed. They do not need to be an SOA member.

2. Ganz – Are we inviting, or are we asking for volunteers?

- a. Newby – We can start with people we know will be interested.

3. Newby – Final proposal for committee to include the SOA the President, Vice President, Past President, one JEDAI Co-Chair, one At-Large Council Member, a member not on council, and one early career/student. Hannah Kemp-Severence motions, Beatty seconds, motion carries.

c. SOA ribbons for conference name badges

- i. Betsy Hedler – We do not currently have ribbons for SOA members. We can do custom ribbons for \$.38 a piece, \$.30 if you get over 100 through our current vendor. It can take up to 20 business days. Rush shipping is available. I can order and bill SOA.

1. McGuire – Some Gahanna vendors may be able to help. They have quick turnaround. I will need to reach out to them individually.

2. Long Morehart calls to approve up to \$300 to purchase SOA name badge ribbons to be used at various conferences/events. McGuire motions, Ganz seconds, motion carries.

d. SOA promotional stickers (email correspondence)

- i. Long Morehart calls to approve \$200 to spend on SOA promotional stickers. McGuire motions, Council At Large Member Darrell Blevins seconds, motion carries.

a. Leadership Transition (Michelle Ganz)

- i. Ganz – I would like to formally resign from my JEDAI Co-Chair position so I can run for SOA Vice President/President Elect. Kris Kallies will be running for the Co-Chair position.

I created 2 different designs using the logo; the first is rectangular and the second is round. The last one is the logo and the tagline for the conference. Let me know if you like one in particular or if you'd like to see a few more options. I can do a funny one or a cartoonish one; I'm using Canva so I have lots of tools.

We can get 500 regular 3 inch round stickers for \$200 or 500 2 inch vinyl ones for \$200

We can get 500 3x2 rectangle vinyl for \$160

They have an economy option where we can get 1000 3 inch ones for \$275 but they are won't be waterproof at all.

The prices go up by about \$75 the larger we go (so 500 4 inch circles are \$273)

We also get a price break the more we buy so 1000 3 inch circles are \$310

The turnaround time is 4 days so we can make this happen very quickly once we decide to move forward.
